- Weight: 250gr., 500 gr. and 1kg.
- Organic certification.
- Variety Amarilla Marangani and Blanca Junin.
- Quinoa from the influence area of the Conservation Concession Alto Huayabamba.
- Produced by the Association of Organics Andean Grains Producers from Bolívar, La Libertad.

- weight: 750 gr.
- 100% natural
- Produced in las Yungas of the Conservation Concession Alto Huayabamba, that protects 143,928.03 ha.
- Availability: February - March / August - september.

- Weight: 110 ml.
- Coconut oil extra virgin.
- Produced by the Consortium Coco Bosque that associates three Concessions for the Conservation of the Central Huallaga Dried Forest in San Martín: Ojos de Agua, Valle del Biavo and El Quinillal (Picota and Bellavista, San Martín), and protect 19,657.231ha.

## Cacao Mucilage



- weight: 250 gr. and 500 gr.
- Cacao honey, a delicate flavor, elaborated with organic fruits harvested by families that preserve the Conservation Concessions Shitariyacu, Tres Quebradas and Gran Simacache, that represent 46,797.130 ha.
- Cacao Mucilage with a 50% reduction 70 Brix, PH 3.5

- weight: 30 ml.
- Pure aguaje oil.
- Fruits coming from the Conservation Concessions Guacamayo and Dos de Mayo de Muyuy in Loreto, and the flood plains Bajo Huallaga in San Martín, that in total sums more than 10,500 ha.

- Weight: 1 kg.
- Fresh mucilage obtained from organic cacaos harvested by families that preserve the Conservation Concessions Shitariyacu, Tres Quebradas and Gran Simacache, that represent 46,797.130 ha.
- Cacao Mucilage with 16 Brix, PH 3.5
